Feeling aggrieved against the alleged long pendency of their review application (Annexure P-1), petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a direction to the learned court below to decide their review application expeditiously.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Keeping in view the nature of prayer made, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present revision petition without issuing notice to the respondent, because no prejudice is going to be caused to the petitioners by passing the instant order.

Keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, coupled with the fact that the review application filed by the petitioners is pending consideration before the learned court below for the last more than 1 ½ years, instant revision petition is disposed of, with a direction to the learned court of Additional District Judge, who is seized of the matter, to make an endeavour to decide the review application of the petitioners at an early date, by passing an appropriate order, however, in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
