Through the instant civil revision preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner seeking issuance of necessary directions to the Sub-Divisional Magistrate (i.e. the Tribunal constituted under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007), Gurdaspur (for short 'Act').

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though the petition under the provisions of the Act was filed on October 06, 2016 and till date nothing substantiated has been done. Now, the case is listed for May 31, 2017 for evidence of the petitioner. But, for the last three dates, the respondent is lingering on the matter without justification and he is not being cross-examined by the respondents on one reason or the other and an attempt is being made by the respondents to delay the disposal of the petition. Since, the petition has been filed under the provisions of the Act, the matter is required to be dealt with and disposed of at the earliest.

Thus, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the learned Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Gurdaspur to take up the matter on priority basis and make an endeavour to finally dispose of the petition but not beyond a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
