Application is allowed as prayed for.

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Though, through the instant revision petition preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the setting aside of orders dated May 25, 2017 and dated May 26, 2017, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Gurugram, whereby two applications i.e. one application dated March 17, 2017 moved by the respondents No.1 to 3 seeking for the release of amount was allowed and second application dated May 26, 2017 moved by the petitioner No.1 for not releasing awarded compensation amount has been dismissed. Yet the learned counsel for the

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petitioners feels satisfied in case the petitioners are allowed to appear and file objection before the Executing Court.

2. Thus, without expressing any opinion with regard to legality of the impugned orders dated May 25, 2017 and dated May 26, 2017, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioners to appear before the Executing Court with further liberty to file objections, if any, which shall be dealt with and disposed of by the Executing Court in accordance with law.
