When this case came up for hearing on 2.6.2017, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to place on record service report and also the zimni orders, whereby petitioner was proceeded against ex parte, so as to show that he was not aware about the pendency of the suit against him.

On his request, adjourned to 11.7.2017.”

Thereafter, another opportunity was granted vide order dated 11.7.2017. However, the abovesaid order dated 2.6.2017 has not been complied so far. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks yet another opportunity which has not been found to be justified.

In view of the above, present revision petition is disposed of, however, with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action but only after ensuring compliance of the abovesaid order dated 2.6.2017.
