Petitioner is seeking direction to the trial Court to decide the application dated 26.05.2017 (Annexure P-17) for directing the concerned SHO to comply with the status quo order dated 05.10.2016 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Malerkotla as well as application dated 26.05.2017 (Annexure P-16) for appointment of Local Commissioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, it transpires that there was a dispute with regard to digging of drain near the southern wall of the newly constructed house of plaintiff-petitioner.

Learned counsel has referred to the letter dated 07.05.2012 (Annexure P-1), which was written by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer to the SHO, Sandhaur, stating that on account of the steps taken by Karamjit Singh, Panchayat has suffered losses as he has dug the

new street upto 03 feet.

Despite passing of status quo order by the trial Court, the respondents have taken steps to dig the drain near the southern wall of the house of present petitioner-plaintiff.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the trial Court to decide the above said two applications expeditiously, in accordance with law.

In the meantime, no further steps will be taken to dig the drain in the street.
