[1]. On 11.09.2017, this case was adjourned in order to ascertain the factum of compromise, if any between the parties.

[2]. Today, Vijay Ahlawat son of the petitioner late Smt. Kusum Bakshi Ahlawat appeared in the Court and stated that there is no chance of amicable resolution of the dispute.

[3]. The controversy involved between the parties is in respect of succession certificate issued in favour of the respondents after the death of Sh. Chattar Singh Ahlawat. Succession certificate was issued on 27.05.2014 by the Addl.

Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Jind.

[4]. An application under Section 151 CPC read with Order 1 Rule 10 CPC and under Section 383 of the Indian Succession Act was moved by the petitioner Smt. Kusum Bakshi Ahlawat when she was alive. The Court of Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Jind vide order dated 02.07.2014 has already called the report of Ahlmad and also summoned the original file from the record room and the application is pending for 05.01.2018 before the Court.

[5]. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, I am of the view that the present petition can be disposed of by directing the trial Court to decide the aforesaid application in accordance with law and it would be just and appropriate also to direct the trial Court to keep implementation of the order dated 27.05.2014 in abeyance till decision of the application. Ordered accordingly.

[6]. In the meanwhile, Mr. Vijay Ahlawat may file an appropriate application for bringing himself on record as legal representative of the deceased Smt. Kusum Bakshi Ahlawat.

[7]. Petitions stands disposed of.
