1. Notice of motion was obtained on 12.07.2017 confined to the prayer of grant of reasonable time to vacate the premises. By default, the petitioner has continued to use and occupy the demised shop for 04½ months, which itself is reasonable time.

2. The petition is dismissed and the petitioner is given one more month's time to vacate the premises by 31.12.2017.

3. The petitioner would deliver the vacant possession of the demised premises by the date fixed failing which respondent can seek police help to execute this order.
