AJAY TEWARI, J.(ORAL)

By this petition the petitioners have challenged the action of the respondents-State of Haryana in not permitting them to ply its bus on the Mansa-Reond route.

The ground taken by the respondents-State of Haryana for denying the petitioners permission to ply their bus in the State of Haryana is that as per the route claimed by the petitioners the distance which would be covered by the bus of the petitioners in the Haryana territory would be more than 16 kms and in that scenario the petitioners were bound to get a permit from the State of Haryana and could not rely on the permit of the State of Punjab.

Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners points out that in the rejoinder to the replication filed the State of Haryana has taken the plea that if the petitioners do not ply its bus to Ratia and go straight to Reond without going to Ratia the distance would be less than 16 kms and that therefore the petitioners would do the route via Chakeriana-Khillan-Phaphre-Bhaike-Hassanpur-Gurne-Budhlada-Kalipur-Mander-Boha-Gamiwal-Lakhiwal-Bahamanwala-Pojanwali-Rattangarh-Bhunder and would not go to Ratia.

Learned Additional Advocate General Haryana states that if the petitioners give up the right to go to Ratia the respondents would have no objection to plying of the bus on the remaining route as detailed above.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
