Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that although the impugned order dated 04.07.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned first appellate Court runs counter to the judicial record, as depicted from the order dated 14.09.2016 passed by the same Court, yet he submits that petitioner will be satisfied in case the learned first appellate Court is directed to hear and decide the appeal at an early date. He further submits that the petitioner shall move an application for preponing the date of hearing within a period of one week from today and the learned Additional District Judge may be directed to consider the said application for preponing the date of hearing in the appeal, so as to decide the appeal itself on merits, but without any further loss of time.

In view of the abovesaid fair statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the said prayer having been found to be a genuine one, instant

revision petition is disposed of, with a direction to the learned first appellate Court to consider the application for preponement to be moved on behalf of the petitioner and after allowing the said application, let the first appeal filed by the defendants be decided at the earliest possible time, so that the petitioner who is a senior citizen may not be put to any further and unwarranted harassment and that too at the hands of his own sons.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present revision petition stands disposed of.
