Counsel for the petitioner-Judgment Debtor made a statement on 18.07.2017 that the petitioner is intending to pay the amount. For that purpose, she is intending to sell a part of the property to satisfy the decree. Learned Executing Court has dismissed the objections and issued conditional warrants of Judgment Debtor.

Learned counsel contends that the warrants of arrest cannot be issued unless the property is put to sale and it is held that the Decree Holder is unable to pay the amount.

There is some substance in the argument.

However, since, Judgment Debtor is willing to pay the amount, therefore, it would be more appropriate if petitioner files an application before the Executing Court for grant of some reasonable time.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is disposed of.
