The plaintiff-petitioner has challenged the order passed by the trial Court vide which Civil Judge (Junior Division), Mohindergarh ordered closing the evidence of the plaintiff.

I have seen certain *zimni* orders produced by the petitioner. Suit in the present case was instituted on 6th of April, 2015. On 09.03.2017, the Court had directed the local Commissioner to record evidence and submit the report, whereas on 19.04.2017 the evidence has been closed by order.

Looking into the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant two more effective opportunities to the plaintiff to conclude its entire evidence. The opportunities would be granted within a

period of six weeks as undertaken by the learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner.

Revision petition is disposed of with the aforesaid observations.

However, defendant would be at liberty to apply for variation in the order passed, if they feel aggrieved.
