ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

The Punjab State Co-operative Supply and Marketing Federation Ltd., Chandigarh-the plaintiff, has filed a revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, against order dated 24.03.2017 (Annexure P-6), whereby the evidence of the plaintiff has been closed by order.

The plaintiff had filed a suit for recovery of Rs.1,12,35,473/- along with interest @ 21% per annum. Subsequently, the suit was transferred to the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, as the dispute was found to be a commercial dispute and hence, it was to be tried under Commercial Act, Commercial Division and Commercial Appellate Division of High Court Act, 2015.

Taking into consideration that plaintiff is an organization of the State of Punjab and recovery of public money is involved.

Therefore, I deem it appropriate to grant one more effective

opportunity. Learned trial court shall grant one more effective opportunity to the plaintiff to conclude its entire evidence on a date to be fixed by the trial court within a period of one month after 21.07.2017.

Revision petition stands disposed of accordingly.
