Defendant in the main suit has filed this revision petition against the order dated 29.04.2017 passed by Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Barnala whereby execution petition filed by decree holder has been disposed of being fully satisfied on the basis of statement of the decree holder.

Civil Suit No.588 was filed by the respondent-Nachhatar Singh against the petitioner on 05.03.2007 for specific performance and permanent injunction. Said suit was decreed vide judgment and decree dated 08.12.2010. Concededly, the said judgment and decree was never assailed in appeal and the same has become final as on date.

Execution filed by the decree holder has been

disposed of being fully satisfied on his statement. The objections once filed by the judgment debtor were dismissed when learned counsel for the judgment debtor did not appear. Judgment debtor still claims himself to be in possession. All these assertions on the part of judgment debtor cannot be adjudicated herein once the execution has already been disposed of being fully satisfied on the basis of statement of decree holder himself.

In view of above, this petition is totally bereft of merits and the same is accordingly dismissed.
