When the case came up for hearing on 24.01.2017, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to place on record relevant zimni orders, showing that plaintiff-petitioner, as a matter of fact, reserved his right for rebutting the evidence of the defendants, despite closing his evidence in affirmative.

On his request, adjourned to 22.2.2017.”

Thereafter, learned counsel for the petitioner sought adjournment on 22.02.2017 seeking more time for complying with the abovesaid order dated 24.01.2017.

As per office report dated 24.07.2017, abovesaid order dated 24.01.2017 has not been complied with by learned counsel for the petitioner so far. There is no justified reason as to why the abovesaid order has not been complied with.

In view of the above, present revision petition is disposed of, however, with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh revision petition on the same cause of action, but only after ensuring strict compliance of the order dated 24.01.2017 passed by this Court.

Disposed of, accordingly.
