Petitioner-tenant is in revision directed against the order dated 24.04.2014 passed by the Appellate Authority, Narnaul, whereby the tenant has been ordered to be evicted from the demises shop situated at Rewari Road, Narnaul, on the ground of '*personal necessity*' of the respondent-landlord, while setting aside the judgment dated 06.10.2010 passed by the Rent Controller, Narnaul, dismissing the eviction petition.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion, vide order dated 17.11.2014 had stayed the execution of the eviction decree subject to certain terms and conditions.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner-tenant, on instructions from his client-*Arvind Kumar Bansal*, who is present in Court, prays for permission to withdraw the present revision petition, as amicable settlement between the petitioner-tenant and respondent-landlord has since been effected.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
