The petitioner-landlord challenges the order dated 4.2.2015 whereby leave to contest has been granted under Section 18-A of the East Punjab Rent Restriction Act, 1949 on the ground that the firm M/s Mohinder Gill and brothers had leased out the property in question and therefore a triable issue arose.

A period of more than two years has gone by and no interim order had been passed as such in the present petition. It is not disputed that the trial is at an advanced stage.

In such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that it would be appropriate if the Rent Controller, Moga who is dealing with the matter is directed to dispose the petition as expeditiously as possible.

Ordered accordingly.

With the aforesaid observations, the present petition is disposed of.
