Feeling aggrieved against alleged long pendency of application (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner for release of his property from attachment in compliance of the order dated 1.3.2016 passed by this Court in CR No. 3684 of 2015 (Nachattar Singh and another Vs. M/s Puran Chand Vinod Kumar and another), petitioner has approached this Court by way of present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for a direction to the learned executing court to decide his pending application at an early date.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner-applicant and without observing anything on merits, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present revision petition is disposed of, with a direction to the learned executing court to decide the application (Annexure P-4), moved by the petitioner for release of his property from attachment, as expeditiously as possible, by passing an appropriate order, in accordance with law.

The learned executing court is further directed to make an endeavour that no undue delay is caused and the respondent is not permitted to delay the decision on the application any more. It is also clarified that in case, petitioner shall move an application for preponement of the date of hearing, learned executing court shall prepone the date of hearing to any earlier convenient date, so as to ensure that pending application of the petitioner is decided without any further delay.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present revision petition stands disposed of.
