At the very inception of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner craves indulgence of this Court for withdrawing the application for bringing on record the legal representatives of deceased-respondent No.2 Sucha Singh on record with a permission to file fresh application before the trial Court with better particulars.

Learned counsel submitted that the application so filed was inherently lacking in respect of material particulars.

Learned counsel relies upon **Indian Bank vs. Sambasivan, 2017(2) CCC 135 (Kerala)** and contended that the application for bringing on record legal representatives of deceased-respondent No.2 Sucha Singh could have been allowed by the trial Court if necessary particulars were pleaded

in the earlier application.

Having perused the material submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to allow this revision petition to be withdrawn with a permission to file an appropriate application before the trial Court in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In the event of filing such an application, the trial Court would be obligated to decide the same in accordance with law at the earliest possible.
