The only grievance of the petitioner is that despite filing an application under Order 39 Rules 1&2 CPC alongwith the suit, the trial Court has not passed any order on the said application. The application was filed in the month of February, 2017 and the trial Court was under legal obligation to decide the application for grant of interim injunction within the prescribed period.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity to call upon the respondents as no order prejudicial to either of the party is being passed.

In view of facts and circumstances of the case, the trial Court is directed to decide the pending application under

Order 39 Rules 1&2 CPC in accordance with law preferably within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
