Counsel for the petitioner would state that the present petition may be disposed of but without prejudice to right of the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the Court below giving up his claim of passing of a decree for possession. However, the petitioner may be given seven days time to file an application and in meantime the trial Court may be directed not to pass an adverse order against the petitioner for his failure to pay the Court fee.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of. The order passed by the trial Court requiring the petitioner to pay the Court fee shall be kept in abeyance for a period seven days in order to enable the petitioner to file an appropriate application without suffering an adverse order. Application, if any, filed by the petitioner, shall be decided by the trial Court, in accordance with law.
