Husband is in revision petition against the order passed by District Judge (Family Court), Faridabad fixing maintenance pendente lite @ ₹ 25,000/- per month.

It is admitted position on the record that the petitioner-husband is drawing a salary of ₹ 1,06,475/- while working with M/s L&T MHPS Boilers Pvt. Ltd.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the husband is paying income tax. He also submits that he is paying some amount to his father.

I have considered the submissions, however, I am unable to agree. The Court has only awarded ₹ 25,000/- to the wife. The amount payable as maintenance pendente lite is not excessive. Hence, there is no scope for interference.

Revision petition is dismissed.
