Prayer in this application is for impleading legal
representatives of deceased-petitioner.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the
same is allowed and legal representatives as shown in para
No.2 of the application are ordered to be brought on record
subject to just exception for the purpose of decision of this
petition only.

Main case

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh,

A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

With the concurrence of both the parties, the case is taken up for disposal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that similar matter i.e. Civil Revision No.4676 of 2017 titled Amanpreet Singh and others vs State of Punjab and others has been decided by the Coordinate Bench of this Court. After setting aside the orders, the case has been remanded to the District Judge, Sangrur on 21.07.2017 for fresh decision in accordance with law. Liberty was given to the District Judge, either to keep the case with him or assign the same to some other Additional District Judge for disposal. A direction was also issued to the Court below to decide the controversy within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Both the parties are *ad idem* that the controversy involved herein is also of the like nature as was involved in the aforesaid civil revision and this revision petition be also disposed of as per the observations made in the aforesaid Civil Revision No.4676 of 2017.

Ordered accordingly.

The case is remanded to the District Judge, Sangrur with a direction either to keep the file with him or mark the same to some other officer for fresh decision in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of

certified copy of this order.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
