RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, fairly states that since during the pendency of the present revision petition, petitioners have released the payment towards salary of the respondent-plaintiff and as a consequence thereof, she has withdrawn her contempt petition, present revision petition has been rendered infructuous. However, he submits that let the present revision petition be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, but it may be clarified that no adverse inference shall be drawn against the petitioners and release of payment on account of salary in favour of the plaintiff-respondent may be treated as without prejudice to the interest of the petitioners.

In view of the abovesaid fair statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, present revision petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Although it goes without saying that no inference shall be drawn against the petitioners, yet it is clarified that the amount released by the petitioners in favour of the plaintiff on account of her claim for salary shall be without prejudice to the petitioners.
