Feeling aggrieved against the order dated 26.07.2017 passed by learned trial court allowing the application of the plaintiff for release of electric connection, the defendants have approached this Court by way of present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority of Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (for short-'PSPCL') that they shall release the electric connection for the premises in question, only if the plaintiff is found entitled of such an electric connection. It is so said because, a direction issued by the learned trial court is not intended to commit any kind of illegality at the hands of any authority of PSPCL.

In such situation, even the defendants-petitioners shall not suffer any kind of prejudice by passing the impugned order.

Having said so that the learned trial court came to the conclusion that no prejudice would be caused to the defendants in restoring the electric connection of the plaintiff.

No other arguments was raised.

Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case coupled with the reasons aforementioned, the present revision petition is dispose of with the above observations, however no orders as to costs.
