Mr.Mahajan, counsel for the petitioners submits that a compromise has been arrived at inter se parties and he has placed the original on record.

A perusal of the said compromise would go on to show that the parties have settled the matter and the petitioner-tenant has paid up to date arrears of rent till 28.02.2017. It has also been mentioned that the landlord-respondent has no objection if the ex parte order of ejectment dated 03.09.2007 passed by the Rent Controller, Amrtisar is set aside and the ejectment application is dismissed. It has further been mentioned that the petitioner would continue to be tenant of the respondent in the demised premises at the rate of Rs.1512.50p per month onwards.

Mr.Gaurav Talwar, Advocate has filed his power of attorney after getting no objection from the earlier counsel and states that he is not in a position to controvert the said averments.

Accordingly, in view of the above, this revision petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

In case of any dispute as such regarding the issue of compromise arises, it is always open for the parties to file an application for revival of the revision petition.
