Plaintiff has filed this revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the order dated 25.07.2017 closing the evidence of the plaintiff.

In this case, the suit was filed in the year 2014. One witness had been summoned along with the record. However, the evidence was closed on the ground that the plaintiff has already availed several opportunities.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant one more effective opportunity to the plaintiff to conclude his evidence. The plaintiff wants to examine the Record Keeper of the office of the Director, Town and Country Planning Department, SCO Nos.71-75, Sector 17-C, Chandigarh alongwith record, who had been summoned.

Since one of the witnesses is official witness, therefore, the Court would grant the plaintiff assistance in summoning the Record Keeper.

The plaintiff would be at liberty to produce whatever evidence he wants to

produce on the next date to be fixed by the Court. No further opportunity shall be granted.

The revision petition is allowed.

The defendants would be at liberty to move an application for modification of the order, if required, as the order is being passed ex parte.
