When the case came up for hearing on 30.01.2017, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Called twice. Neither anybody has come present to argue the case nor any request for pass over has been made.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 15.02.2017.”

Again on 15.02.2017, none appeared and following order was passed by this Court:-

“Neither anybody has come present on behalf of the appellant to argue the appeal nor any request for pass over has been made.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 26.05.2017.”

Similar is the position today. Neither anybody has come present to argue the revision petition nor any request for pass over has been made. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present revision petition.

Under these circumstances, this Court is left with no option except to dismiss this case for non-prosecution.

Accordingly, instant revision petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
