Judgment Debtor has filed this revision petition against the order dated 27.03.2017. The objections filed by the Judgment Debtor have been dismissed by the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) has submitted that the petitioner(s) had some independent right as Thakri Devi had sold some property to one Chiranji Lal in the year 1977. Chiranji Lal had thereafter sold the property to the petitioner(s) on 07.01.1985.

From a perusal of the file, I find that the objections filed by the petitioner(s) do not depict this position. There is no pleadings to this effect in the objection petition.

For the reasons recorded above, I do not find any ground to interfere with the impugned order passed by the Court. However, if the petitioner has any independent right apart from being LRs of Lt. Harbans

Lal one of the defendant, he shall be at liberty to move appropriate application before the Court.

Revision petition is dismissed.
