Present revision petition is directed against the order dated 13.8.2015 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, whereby miscellaneous appeal of the defendants against the order dated 20.1.2014 passed by the learned court below, allowing the application of the plaintiffs under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC, was dismissed.

This is the 8th date in a row. Case has been repeatedly adjourned either on oral or written requests made on behalf of the petitioners. Similar is the position today. Neither anybody has come present on behalf of the petitioners to press this revision petition, nor any request for pass over has been made. Further, in all probability, suit would have been decided by the learned trial court, rendering the revision petition as infructuous.

In the circumstances of the case, instant revision petition is ordered to be disposed of, with liberty to the petitioners to get it revived, if necessity arises.
