This order will dispose of CR Nos. 5667 and 6305 of 2017 as these have emerged out of the same proceedings i.e. divorce petition titled 'Deepak Sareen v Nidhi Sareen' pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the petitions may be disposed of in the following terms:-

- i) Nidhi Sareen alias Ravita shall ensure that Deepak Sareen is cross examined on 20.09.2017, the date fixed in the case for cross examination of Deepak Sareen; and

- ii) Counsel for the parties have got no objection if order dated 11.08.2017 closing right of the respondents to cross examine Nitin Chauhan (PW4) is set aside and the respondents are given one opportunity to cross examine Nitin Chauhan (PW4) on 07.10.2017 subject to payment of Rs.10,000.00 as costs by Nidhi Sareen alias Ravita.

In view of the above, the petitions stand disposed of. However, after conclusion of evidence of Deepak Sareen, the trial Court shall put its best efforts to expedite recording of evidence of the respondents therein but by providing adequate opportunity to the respondents to conclude their evidence, in accordance with law.
