Learned counsel for the plaintiff-respondent refers to the order dated 25.11.2016 passed by the learned trial court, dismissing the suit as withdrawn, to submit that present revision petition does not survive any further and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Faced with the above, learned proxy counsel submits that since order dated 25.11.2016 is a judicial order, whereby the suit itself has been withdrawn, present revision petition would not survive any further and may be disposed of, as such.
