Feeling aggrieved against the order dated 30.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned trial Court, whereby amendment in the plaint was declined, plaintiff has approached this Court by way of present civil revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for setting aside the impugned order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is a matter of record that the suit was filed by the plaintiff in January, 2013. It is the suit for possession by way of specific performance of agreement to sell dated 20.05.2011 extended upto 30.11.2012. It has gone undisputed before this Court that treating the plaint to be correct, plaintiff-petitioner started leading his evidence and concluded the same. Thereafter, defendants started and concluded their evidence. When the case came at the

stage of rebuttal evidence and for arguments, plaintiff filed the present application under Order 6 Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure (for short 'CPC') and also under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present revision petition.

Permission is granted.
