Plaintiff is in revision petition against the order dated 28.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Mohindergarh, closing the right of the plaintiff to lead evidence.

Learned Court has noticed that the plaintiff has already availed seven effective opportunities but has not concluded its evidence.

Although, there is no illegality in the order passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Mohindergarh, however, in the interest of justice, plaintiff is granted one effective opportunity to produce his entire evidence on 12.09.2017, the date already fixed before the trial Court. This opportunity will be subject to the payment of the cost of ₹2,000/-.
