Applicant-petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the revision petition with liberty to file fresh one.

On the oral request made by learned counsel for the applicant, date of hearing is ordered to be preponed from 24.03.2017 to today. Revision petition is taken up for final disposal.

When the revision petition came up for hearing before this Court on 30.01.2017, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Notice of motion for 24.03.2017 subject to payment of Rs.50,000/- to the respondent-wife by way of bank draft.

Subject to payment of abovesaid amount, operation of the impugned order beyond Rs.12,000/- per month shall remain stayed.”

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that after filing the revision petition, the learned Court below modified the impugned order dated 05.11.2016 by passing an order dated 15.02.2017, which has

necessitated filing the present application for withdrawal of the revision petition with permission to file fresh one against the amended order dated 15.02.2017, if necessity arises.

After hearing the learned counsel for the applicant, instant application is allowed. Applicant-petitioner is permitted to withdraw the revision petition with liberty to file fresh one to lay challenge to the order dated 15.02.2017, as prayed for by learned counsel for the applicant.

Disposed of, accordingly.
