For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, legal representatives of deceased-Pritam Singh as mentioned in the application are ordered to be brought on record for the purpose of prosecuting the present revision petition.

Application stands allowed.

Main Case

The defendant Nos.1 and 2 have filed the present revision petition against the order dated 02.05.2017 passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned Civil Judge has ordered that all natural heirs be brought on record as legal heirs of Baljinder Kaur-deceased. Defendant Nos.1 and 2 are claiming inheritance on the basis of a Will dated 09.11.2006

which is being disputed by the other natural heirs. In these circumstances, the Court has ordered that all natural heirs be brought on record for the purpose of prosecution of the present case.

The order is only for the purpose of prosecuting the case. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that one of the natural heirs is plaintiff. She would be now defendant also.

I have considered the submission. All the natural heirs have been impleaded. If the plaintiff is already a party, she would continue to represent the estate of Late Smt. Baljinder Kaur as plaintiff only she is not to be impleaded as defendant because she is already party to the proceedings.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is dismissed.
