Feeling aggrieved against the alleged long pendency of the application before the learned trial court, permitting the petitioner to file the requisite stamp duty, petitioner has approached this Court by way of present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for seeking direction to the learned trial court for early disposal of the application.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and going through the numerous zimni orders, this Court is of the considered opinion that there is no delay on the part of the learned trial court. Whatever was the delay, it was only because of the fault of the petitioner. Under these circumstances, no time bound directions deserve to be issued, at the hands of this Court.
