Judgment-Debtor is in revision petition against the order dismissing the objections filed by her in the execution petition.

It is not in dispute that a decree for specific performance of the agreement to sell was passed on the basis of a compromise deed dated 20.07.2016.

Judgment-Debtor has pleaded that the decree is false, frivolous and fraudulent.

The decree passed by the Court has not been challenged in any proceedings. In the execution petition, it is being alleged that the decree is false, frivolous and fraudulent.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the Decree Holder has brought to my notice that in an earlier injunction suit, Judgment Debtor had

admitted the claim of the Decree Holder as is proved from reading of the order dated 28.01.2014.

The Courts have noticed that a compromise deed Ex.C1 bears the signatures of the Judgment Debtor on each and every page.

In view of what has been stated above, I do not find any good ground to interfere with the order passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kurukshetra, which is well-reasoned.

Revision petition is dismissed.

All pending miscellaneous applications are disposed of, in view of the aforesaid order.
