Present revision petition is directed against the order dated 09.04.2016 as well as order dated 30.04.2016, passed by Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Anandpur Sahib, whereby he has ordered certain steps to be taken for handing over the possession to the respondents, as also for affording police help for this purpose.

It has been urged by learned counsel for the petitioners that the objections raised by the petitioners were entertained but no order was passed therein. Thus, order is non-speaking in nature. He submits that matter be remanded back to the same court for decision afresh after hearing the parties. He undertakes that he will not raise any plea for framing issues or for leading evidence.

In view of this undertaking given by counsel for the petitioners, matter is remitted to the same court for decision afresh after hearing the parties. As the order passed is silent as regards objections raised by the petitioners, trial court would pass a speaking order and proceed further with the execution. In case petitioners try to delay the proceedings, it shall be at liberty to impose some exemplary costs. Entire proceedings be completed expeditiously, in any case not later than two months.

Petition is disposed of in these terms.
