Petitioner (tenant) is in revision directed against the order dated 24.08.2017 passed by the learned Rent Controller, Amritsar whereby application of the tenant for appointing Local Commissioner to determine the damage caused to the roof of the demised shop on the first floor in the pending eviction petition, has been dismissed.

It is submitted that the respondent (landlord) is seeking eviction of the petitioner (tenant) from the demised shop on the first floor on the ground of non payment of rent and personal necessity. Thus, the issue of damage to the premises of the demised shop are irrelevant for adjudication in the pending eviction petition.

After arguing for sometime and having failed to convince the Court counsel prays for permission to withdraw the present revision to enable his client to seek proper remedy as per law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
