Petitioners have come up in revision against the order dated 19.01.2017 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurgaon, whereby their evidence has been closed by order and they have not been allowed to examine any handwriting and fingerprints expert.

A perusal of the order dated 25.10.2016 shows that the trial Court had dismissed an application for examining the handwriting expert. While dismissing the application, it has been observed that the Bank Manager had appeared as AW-2 and stated that the amount mentioned in the cheque bearing No.614959 dated 07.12.2009 had been deposited in the account of Shri R.R. Chauhan.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioners wanted

to examine the handwriting expert to examine the writing on the receipt, by

which the amount had been withdrawn by presentation of the aforesaid cheque. He further states that a blank cheque was taken by the respondent during business transactions.

Since an application to examine handwriting of respondent on the receipt has been dismissed vide order dated 25.10.2016 and evidence has already been closed, no ground is made out to interfere in the impugned order. Moreover, the order dated 25.10.2016 has already attained the finality.

Resultantly, finding no merits, the present petition is dismissed.
