Petitioner (tenant) is in revision directed against the concurrent findings returned by the Authorities below whereby he has been ordered to be evicted on the ground of personal necessity and change of user by learned Rent Controller, Palwal vide order dated 25.01.2016 and the findings thereof were affirmed by learned Appellate Authority, Palwal vide judgment dated 17.08.2017.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner (tenant) concedes that the present revision has become infructuous in the light of the possession having been delivered to the landlord/decreed holder through the process of the Court as noticed in the order dated 09.10.2017 of the Executing Court which is on record at Flag-A.
