REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The present dispute pertains to service benefits of Sandeep Kumar (since deceased) as there is a dispute between his mother (petitioner herein) and his widow (respondent No.4 herein) though admittedly the deceased left behind his minor son as well.

Counsel for the petitioner and respondent No.4 have arrived at a consensus that the present petition may be disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 that the financial benefits payable on death of Sandeep Kumar to the extent of 2/3rd (if not released earlier) may be released in favour of Poonam Kumari and son of the deceased and the remaining 1/3rd may be deposited in a fixed deposit receipt payable to the successful party subject to outcome of the civil suit by the trial Court.

In view of above, the present petition stands disposed of.
