Plaintiffs are in revision petition against the order passed by the trial Court setting aside the ex parte proceedings.

It is not in dispute that the suit is pending. Although, learned counsel for the petitioners has tried to persuade me by showing that the defendants were served. However, in exercise of the jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, it would not be appropriate for this Court to interfere with an order by permitting the defendants to appear and contest the suit on merits.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further prayed that the trial of the case is pending for five years.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, learned trial Court is requested to expedite the trial of the case as the suit is already five years old.

With these observations, revision petition is disposed of.
