Defendant is in revision petition against the order dated 22.08.2017 closing the evidence of the defendant.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that defendant started his evidence on 24.03.2017. No doubt, seven opportunities were granted, however, defendant could not conclude his evidence as the defendant was falsely implicated in a criminal case pending in Uttar Pradesh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that he would conclude his entire evidence if one effective opportunity is granted.

Keeping in view the aforesaid fact and the undertaking given by the learned counsel, the order dated 22.08.2017 is modified and learned trial Court is requested to provide one effective opportunity to the defendant to lead his entire evidence. Such opportunity would be within a period of one month from today. However, this opportunity to lead

evidence would be subject to the payment of Rs.10,000/- as cost.

Revision petition is allowed.

Since, I am disposing of this revision petition without issuing notice, the plaintiff would be at liberty to move an application for recall, if he so desired.
