Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 07.01.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, whereby evidence of plaintiff-petitioners has been closed by order.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that earlier, the trial Court had granted last opportunity to plaintiff-petitioners to conclude their evidence, subject to costs of ₹500/-. Moreover, they had availed 07 opportunities to conclude their evidence, but failed to do so.

However, in the given circumstances of the case, to impart complete justice to the parties and also to avoid deprivation of full opportunity to the petitioners, this Court deems it appropriate to provide some time to the petitioners (plaintiffs) to conclude their evidence.

In view of the above, the impugned order dated 07.01.2017 (Annexure P-2) is set aside and one effective opportunity is granted to

plaintiff-petitioners to conclude their entire evidence, subject to costs of

₹3,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Service Authority,
Ludhiana.

Allowed accordingly.
