Petitioner (tenant) is in revision directed against the order dated 05.09.2017 passed by learned Rent Controller, Sangrur whereby the application of the tenant under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC for amendment of the written statement at the stage of evidence of the tenant has been dismissed.

Concededly the eviction is sought on the ground of personal necessity for expanding the floor area of the separate shop in possession of the son of the landlord by demolishing the partition walls of two other shops on rent including the demised shop in the present case. As per the technical expert report, if the walls of the shops are removed there is likelihood of the entire structure coming down. Due

to this fact the tenant wishes to assert that the need is not bonafide by amendment of the written statement.

After arguing for sometime and having failed to convince this Court, prays for permission to withdrawn the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
