Learned counsel for the respondent, at the very outset, fairly states that he has got no objection in case all the three execution applications are ordered to be consolidated and decided together by the learned executing court. He further submits that this concession was given even before the learned court below when the impugned order dated 11.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) was passed.

In view of the above, present revision petition is allowed. Impugned order dated 11.08.2016 passed by the learned court below is hereby set aside. It is ordered that all the three execution applications shall be consolidated and decided together by the learned court of competent jurisdiction.

Resultantly, with the above-said observations made and directions issued, instant revision petition stands allowed, however, with no order as to costs.
