The Decree Holder is in revision petition against the order passed by the Executing Court, whereby the issues have been framed.

In this case, the decree was passed on 19.12.2014. The third party had filed the objections on which the issues have been framed. Since, the third party objections are to be decided like a suit, therefore, no error can be found in the order passed by the Executing Court. However, the Courts are required to balance the equities. The decree holder cannot be deprived of the fruits of the decree for long time.

In these circumstances, the Executing Court is requested to decide the objection petition positively within a period of six months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is disposed of.
