Feeling aggrieved against the alleged long pendency of partition proceedings between the parties before the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Jagadhri, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant revision petition, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for a direction to the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade, Jagadhri, for early decision of the partition proceedings.

Notice of motion was issued.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

It has gone undisputed before this Court that the parties are closely related with each other. Matter is also pending before the civil court.

In this view of the matter, the Assistant Collector 2nd Grade,

Jagadhri, shall make a sincere effort to get the matter settled amicably

between the parties. He shall also be at liberty to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at Jagadhri. However, if the parties fail to arrive at an amicable settlement, he shall decide the partition proceedings after granting sufficient and reasonable opportunity to both the parties to put up their case, by passing an appropriate order, strictly in accordance with law.

Resultantly, with the above-said observations made and directions issued, present revision petition stands disposed of.
