At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only grievance of the petitioner at this stage is that since the services of the petitioner have already been terminated and the amount awarded in terms of proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. has not been adjusted, therefore, the petitioner may be permitted to approach the same Court for seeking modification of the order in view of changed circumstances.

In view of assertion made by learned counsel for the

petitioner, it would be just and appropriate to allow him to withdraw the present revision petition with a liberty to approach the Court of Addl. District Judge, Chandigarh for fresh assessment in view of the changed circumstances.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

The petitioner would be at liberty to lead evidence in the context of termination of his service and also to satisfy the Court in the context of amount awarded in terms of proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C.
